

The McDonald's 10k Grand Slam Giveaway Contest (hereinafter referred to as "Contest") is open to legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry.

Employees of McDonald's, The City of Goodyear, the Cleveland Guardians, the Cincinnati Reds, their affiliated companies and their immediate family members and persons living in their same household, are not eligible to participate in the Contest.

Contest begins on February 21, 2026 and will end on March 22, 2026 or if a member of the home team at Goodyear Ballpark hits a grand slam homerun in the 3rd inning of a 2026 MLB spring training game, the contest will end.

To enter, participants must be present at the current game on day of the contest and submit a completed form at: Goodyearbp.com/10kcontest. Each game day will begin a new entry period, which will be from the time gates open (90 minutes prior to scheduled first pitch), to the first pitch of the game. One entry, per person, per game will be accepted. Entries submitted before or after the Entry Period will not be eligible for consideration.

Selected participant will be notified by the middle of the third inning. Participant will need to confirm eligibility and may be required to sign and return an Affidavit of Eligibility. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in disqualification. Participant will be announced in the middle of the 3rd inning. If a grand slam homerun is hit, winner will be notified immediately upon ruling by the official scorer.

In order to qualify for Prize reimbursement, during a 2026 Goodyear Ballpark Spring Training baseball game, a team member of the home team must hit a Grand Slam Home Run in the 3rd inning of the game. The Grand Slam Home Run must be counted and scored by the official scorer as an official Grand Slam Home Run for a total of 4 runs. A play nullified by a penalty or otherwise is ineligible to win. The eligibility of the Grand Slam is subject to MLB Rules. The schedule of Prize Awards: \$10,000.00.

The prize is non-transferable and may not be substituted for any other prize or cash value. The winner is solely responsible for any taxes associated with the prize.
